## Elders Fun Day 2023 - Ageing Games

Ageing Games 2023 was organized to honour the late former Chairman and Vice Chairman of DAGOMO Foundation, **Surv. Daniel Aiyanyo** and **Barr. Grace Onaiwu Omoigui** who died on **November 19, 2016**, and **November 24, 2022**.

The idea behind “**Ageing Games**” as a theme was to host a series of fun games with teams made of both old and young people thus promoting inter-generational bonding, learning, building compassion in the youth for the elderly, and bridging the age gap. It was a platform to advocate for the direct impact of physical and mental exercise on overall wellbeing – using blood pressure, and heart rate indices as a measure of success before and after the activities.

Accordingly, as in all our programs, we conducted a medical outreach at the same time to collect such data, monitor and track the overall well-being of participants, and glean data that facilitates data-driven interventions.

- The results from the **194** participants on both days showed:
- An average of **9.8%** short-term increase in the heart rates of game participants.
  - **15.5%** decrease in the blood pressure levels of beneficiaries that presented with elevated blood pressure levels from the first day
  - No significant change in the sugar levels of game participants.



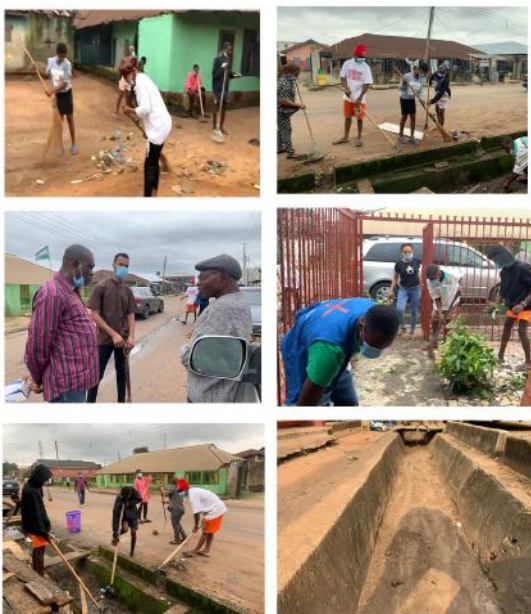
## Pa Elekhuoba Memorial Outreach 2023 and Keep Igun Clean Campaign

The Igun Street Community in Benin City, Edo State plays host to the yearly “**Pa Elekhuoba Memorial Outreach**” on December 18, in honour of Late. Pa. Elekhuoba Asemota, a man of great leadership qualities, epitome of good moral standards, and dedication to community growth and advancement.

The “**Keep Igun Clean**” campaign was simultaneously executed by the DAGOMO staff and team of volunteers, who carried out a cleaning exercise; taking time to thoroughly clear the gutters, surroundings, road-side and the mausoleum of Pa Elekhuoba.

Members of the community were once again delighted to see the result of the cleaning exercise, benefit from the free health checks.

The Keep Igun Clean volunteer team has also grown to over **20** members who are dedicated to carry out quarterly thorough cleaning of the Igun Street environs.





## WeCare Medical Mission 2023 - Igarra, Edo State

The DAGOMO Annual Medical Mission organized in honor of the late Vice Chairman of DAGOMO Foundation, Barr. Mrs. Grace Onaiwu Omoigui is a platform to promote the principles and practice of healthy aging, advocate for improved hygiene in the elderly, and promote access to continued health care for the under privileged.

This medical mission objective was to promote the principles and practice of healthy aging across all age groups through free vital signs checks, dental screening, distribution of free drugs and an assessment of access to quality care for beneficiaries in the **Igarra community, Edo State**.

The mission also provided free **1 year health insurance coverage** to **100 beneficiaries** in partnership with the **Edo State Health Insurance Commission**.

### Impact:

1. The number of free vitals check conducted - **166**
2. The number of dental checks and procedures carried out - **28 Scaling and Polishing and 5 Extractions**
3. The number of recipients of free drugs - **154**
4. The number of free eye checks carried out - **21**
5. The number of free glasses distributed - **7**
6. The number of beneficiaries tested positive for malaria - **13**
7. The number of beneficiaries enrolled on the free one-year health insurance scheme - **49**
8. The number of "Access to Care Feedback" data received - **166**
